

Village goes to battle in Knock Out contest

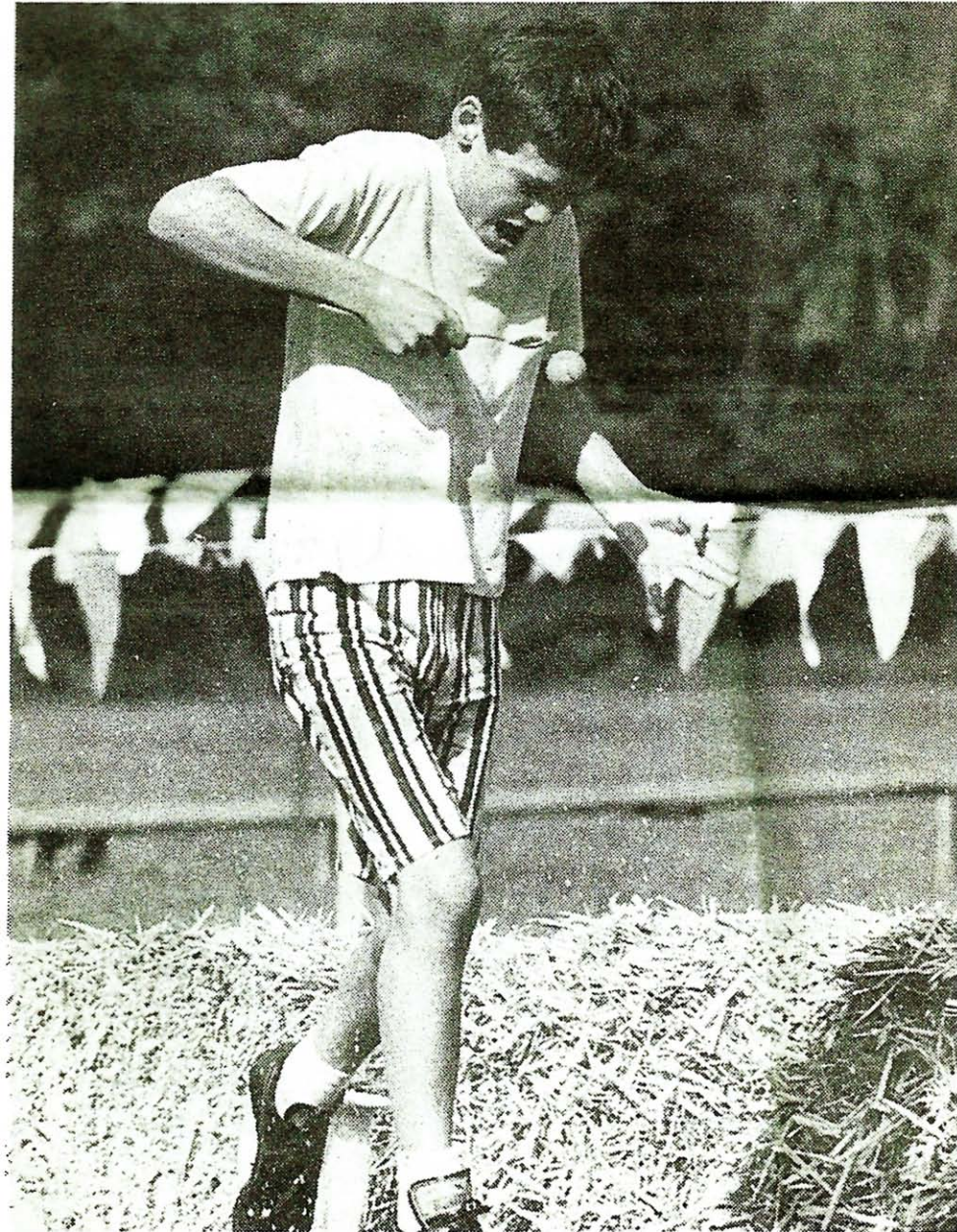
CRAZY It's a Knock Out races were the highlight of Nayland Community Council's fair held on the village playing field yesterday.
